You'll have a ball as you explore this home to more than 11,400 exotic animals - many of which are rare and endangered. You'll see animals that represent the major continents and biomes of the world!



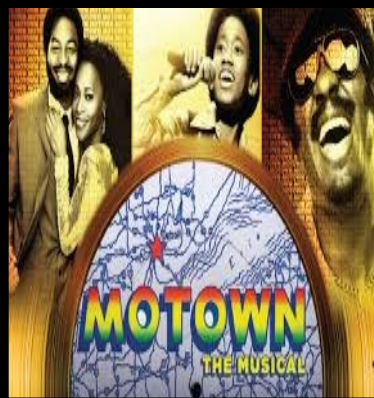
St. Louis Fun Facts

Payment Schedule

Due: September 16, 2016	\$100.00 per person booking deposit
Due: December 10, 2016	20% installment payment
Due: January 9, 2017	20% installment payment
Due: February 8, 2017	Final balance

Participants are expected to follow the payment schedule as outlined. Any special arrangements must be made with Entourage Management prior to the payment due date. All participants that are not paid in full at 30-days prior to the trip will be removed from the trip with no refund.

Room Assignments

Students will be assigned 4 to a room. Suite accommodations feature 2 queen beds plus a pull out sofa. Students will sign up for roommates in class in December. Students rooming together will be riding together. Any special requests must be made prior to the rooming list being compiled.
